## A TOTAL OF 27 AWARDS GRANTED AT THE WELCOME POLICY CEREMONY



On October 10, 2018, the Town of Stanstead, in collaboration with the Caisse Desjardins du Lac-Memphremagog, distributed Welcome Policy grants to 22 new home owners in Stanstead. The Town also presented 7 Growing Family awards to families with new children.

The Welcome Policy is intended for parents of new children, as well as new home owners in Stanstead.

In order to qualify, a registration form must be completed and submitted to the Town within 6 months following

the birth or adoption of a child. For those who have built or purchased a new home, registration must be received by the Town within 6 months of contract signing and notarization. Please note that you must attach a copy of valid ID with your registration form.

*in Brief*



- Please note that an extraordinary session of the municipal council will take place on **Tuesday, December 11, 2018** at 6 p.m. for the adoption of the 2019 budget and the triennial capital expenditures program;
- Temporary shelters for commercial or residential use are allowed from October 1, 2018 thru April 30, 2019. Shelters must be installed 1.5 meters from the public right-of-way;
- Parking permits are required for parking a vehicle in one of the three municipal parking lots. To obtain a parking permit, visit the Town Hall to pay the \$50 fee for the 2018-2019 winter season;
- Winter parking is in effect from November 1, 2018 thru April 1, 2019: In order for the Town to facilitate the clearing and care of roads throughout the winter months, citizens are asked to ensure that vehicles parked in private driveways are at least one meter from the sidewalk or the side of the road or curb. It is forbidden to park on municipal roads between the hours of 11 p.m. and 8 a.m.

## NEW REGULATIONS FOR GARBAGE COLLECTION

The Town of Stanstead would like to inform its citizens that **effective January 1, 2019**, new regulations concerning the bins used for garbage collection will apply.

Starting that date, **only wheeled bins of a maximum size of 360 litres and a colour other than blue or brown will be accepted.**

Thus, any other bin that does not respect these standards or any bin originally blue or brown, but having been painted or modified as black (or any other colour) will not be picked up by the contractor.

As a reminder, note that the colour blue is reserved for the collection of recyclable materials and the colour brown is uniquely for the collection of organic materials (compost).

Citizens who already have a bin responding to the standards mentioned in this announcement may, of course, continue to use it. For citizens seeking to acquire a new bin, it is possible to purchase one at the store or to place your order with the Town by

**November 30, 2018** at the latest for the sum of \$110. Note that bin delivery is available from the Town for a fee of \$10.

To ensure the smooth operation of the collection of residual waste including garbage, recyclable materials and compost, here is a **reminder of instructions to follow:**

- Place your bins by the edge of the road after 7 p.m. the evening before the collection and no later than 7 a.m. the morning of the collection and remove them by 9 p.m. on the day of the collection;
- Position your bins near the sidewalk, street border or right-of-way without obstructing access and ensuring that there is sufficient space around your bins and that the wheels and handle are facing your property;
- Put all materials inside the bin, as no materials placed outside the bin will be collected by the contractor.

For collection dates, please consult the **calendar** available on the Town of Stanstead website. The calendar for the period of the year 2019 will be sent out by mail during the month of December 2018.
