Town Councillor Joshua Richer Will Not Fulfil Mandate

Stanstead, April 22, 2021 – During the April 12, 2021, municipal council meeting, Town of Stanstead municipal councillor Joshua Richer issued his resignation from seat no. 5. Mr. Richer was absent from the meeting and the mayor, Mr. Philippe Dutil read the letter of resignation which is to take effect on April 30, 2021.

Having moved outside the territory of the Town of Stanstead, Mr. Richer was no longer eligible to sit as a municipal councillor. Despite his desire to finish the mandate, ending in November 2021, Mr. Richer chose rather to resign in order to avoid potential issues in the future. « Joshua was an excellent councillor, » stated Mr. Dutil. « We are sorry to lose him and I wish him all the best in his future projects. »

Joshua Richer was elected in the last municipal election, held in 2017. It was his first and only mandate as a municipal councillor.
