The Town of Stanstead Launches Summer Program: *My First Job in Town*

Stanstead, May 6, 2021 – Town of Stanstead municipal council members are proud to announce the launch of the program: *My First Job in Town*. This new initiative aims to offer the youth of Stanstead the chance to obtain first-time job experience. Two positions are offered: office assistance and public works day worker.

Stanstead mayor, Mr. Philippe Dutil, explains the motivation behind this project: "The future of our youth is a priority for the council. It is important for the Town to support young people even after they finish high school. We need to give the opportunity to access the job market."

The initiative is launched in collaboration with the Compass Program team at Phelps Helps who will offer free accompaniment in the creation of a curriculum vitae, help in preparing for interviews and general guidance for the process.
